Hosting “*Connecting Springfield to the World – A Virtual WiMAX Historical Tour*” to showcase power of 4G wireless internet

Xanadoo Company is commercializing WiMAX wireless broadband technology over 2.5 GHz licensed frequencies. WiMAX, also known as IEEE 802.16e, is a 4th generation (4G) wireless technology standard that offers users speeds comparable to wireline technologies, like cable and DSL, with the mobility of traditional cellular voice services. Xanadoo has rights to 2.5 GHz licenses covering approximately 8 million people in Texas, Arkansas, Illinois, Kansas, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, Oklahoma and West Virginia. Xanadoo is also a licensee of 700 MHz spectrum covering almost 156 million people in major markets, such as New York, Boston, Philadelphia, Pittsburgh, Cleveland, Detroit, Chicago, Miami, Tampa, San Francisco, Sacramento, Portland and Seattle. Xanadoo expects that 4G wireless technologies will also be deployed in the 700 MHz frequency band.
